



EQUAL OPPORTUNITY IS THE LAW

It is against the law for this recipient of federal financial assistance to discriminate on the following:

- Against any individual in the United States on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, age, disability, political affiliation or belief, and
- Against any beneficiary of programs financially assisted under Title I of the Workforce Investment Act (WIA) of 1998 on the basis of the beneficiary's citizenship/status as a lawfully admitted immigrant authorized to work in the United States or his/her participation in any WIA Title I-financially assisted program or activity.

The recipient must not discriminate in:

- Decision on whom may be admitted, or have access, to any WIA Title I-financially assisted program or activity;
- Provision of opportunities in, or treatment to any person with regard to such a program or activity; or
- Employment decisions in the administration of, or in connection with, such a program or activity.
